Texas PRIMA RISING STAR AWARD

PURPOSE:

This award recognizes an individual who is relatively new to the field of risk management and has exemplified leadership potential, achievement in the field, and professional development.

THE AWARD:

- Texas PRIMA's Rising Star Award will be presented during Texas PRIMA's Annual Conference.
- Notification of the award will be sent to the recipient's supervisor.
- The recipient will receive complimentary conference registration and one night of hotel accommodations.
- The recipient will receive a wall plaque.
- The recipient will be recognized in the Texas PRIMA newsletter, Texas PRIMA Press.
- The recipient will be recognized on the Texas PRIMA website and social media platforms.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Candidate must be a full-time professional, employed by the same public entity for a minimum of two consecutive vears.
- Candidate must have at least 2, but no more than 7 years of professional experience in the risk and insurance management industry.
- Regardless of the candidate's position and/or title, primary areas of responsibility must be in the risk and insurance industry. (Discipline categories include risk management, benefits, loss prevention, workers' compensation, safety management, insurance procurement, self-insured programs, claims management, etc.)
- Candidate must be a current, active member of Texas PRIMA.
- Candidate have been an active member of Texas PRIMA for at least 2 of the past 5 years.
- Current Texas PRIMA board members are not eligible to receive this Award.

NOMINATIONS:

• Candidate may nominate him/herself or can be nominated by a Texas PRIMA Board member, a sponsoring entity of Texas PRIMA, or by an active member of Texas PRIMA.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Once nominated, the candidate will receive an Evaluation Criteria form that he or she must complete and return to Texas PRIMA by the indicated deadline.
- Winner selection of the Texas PRIMA Rising Star Award is made by the Texas PRIMA Board. Each board member will individually and numerically rank candidates without discussion or conference with any other board member.
- The candidate with the most points allotted by the Texas PRIMA Board will be determined the winner.
- Nominated candidate must meet all eligibility requirements to be considered for Award.
