

Museums

- Museum of Pop Culture Explore exhibits on music, film, and gaming.
- <u>The Museum of Flight</u> A fascinating look at aviation history, with real aircraft and space exhibits.
- <u>Seattle Art Museum</u> A diverse collection of art, from contemporary to Indigenous works.

Live Sports and Outdoor Activities

- Whale Watching The southern resident Orcas typically travel through the San Juan Islands from May through October, and Seattle is lucky enough to spot gray and humpback whales year-round.
